- **Spill clean-up sites, short term environmental remediation sites**
- **Short term construction camps, disaster relief camps**

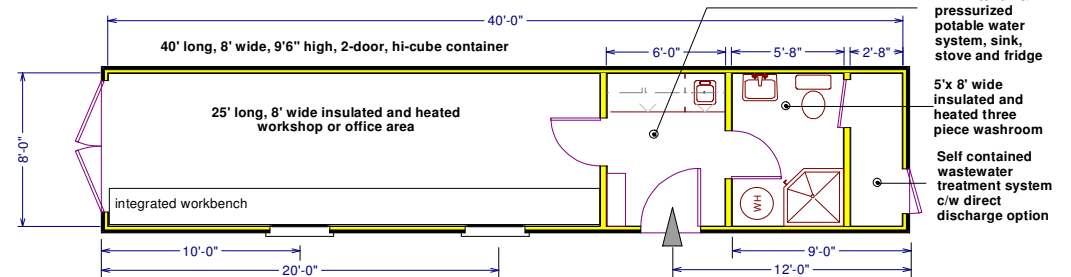
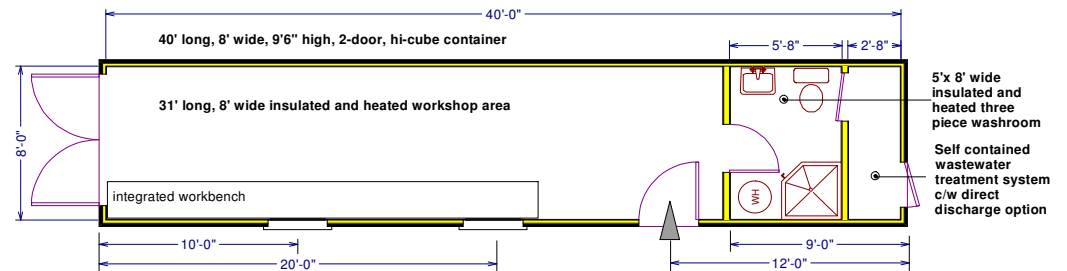
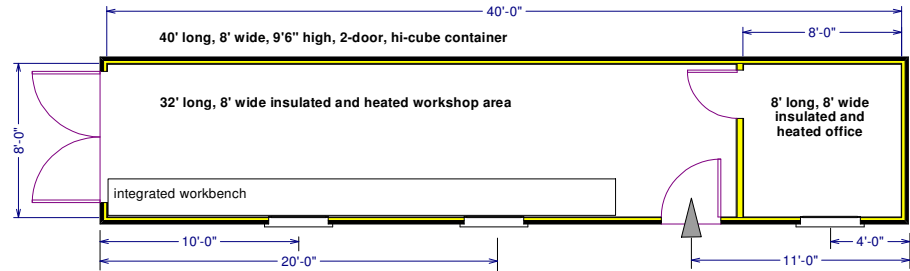
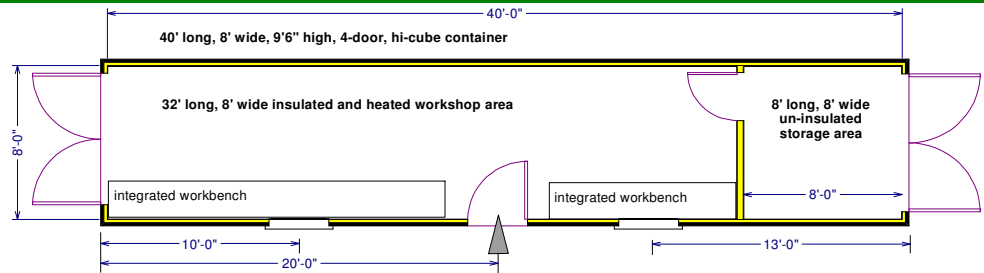
For example, the container units combine an **office module** with a self contained washroom and (if requested) with a completely self contained potable water supply and wastewater treatment.
